OVERLAND ALOR SETAR - GEORGETOWN PENANG (150 KM) (B)

After breakfast you travel to Penang and start on a city, culture and heritage tour of Georgetown which was officially declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2008. Included in the tour is a visit to the ornate Kek Lok Si Temple built in 1904. It is the most beautiful and largest Buddhist temple complex in South East Asia and is known as the Temple of the 1,000 Buddhas. Proceed to Fort Cornwallis which was the landing site of Captain Francis Light in 1786. He arrived to start the first British colony in Penang. Next Stop is a visit to the water village of the Clan Jetties at Weld Quay, so named as residents of each jetty share similar surname. Now walk along Pitt Street, also known as the 'Street of Harmony' as churches, Chinese temples, mosques and Hindu temples have existed along the same street in harmony side by side for centuries. Also visit the intricate Khoo Kong Si clan house and enjoy a breezy trishaw ride; still popular mode of transport in Georgetown.
