### Day - 3 Penang

#### **PENANG: DISCOVERY TOUR OF GEORGETOWN (B)**

Depart from hotel for a City, Culture and Heritage tour of **Georgetown**, which has been **official, declared** as a **UNESCO SITE** in **2008**. Visit the **3rd longest reclining Buddha figure** in the world followed by **Kek Lok Si Temple**, also known as **Temple of 1000 Buddhas** that was **built** in **1904**. It is the most **beautiful** and **largest Buddhist temple complex** in **South East Asia**. Next, visit **Fort Cornwallis**, the landing site of **Captain Francis Light** in **1786** when he arrived to start the **first British colony** in **Penang**. The **tour carries** on with a **visit** to the **water village** of **The Clan Jetties at Weld Quay**, so named as **residents of each jetty share similar surname**. Walk afterwards along **Pitt Street**, also known as “**The Street of Harmony**”. Here **churches, Chinese temples, mosques** and **Hindu temples** are **built** along the same street in **harmonious existence** side by side for **centuries**. Visit the intricate **Khoo Kong Si clan’s house**. Enjoy a **breezy trishaw ride**, a still popular mode of transport in **Georgetown**. Return to the hotel and the **rest of the day is at your own leisure**. In the late evening, you can explore the **nightlife** along **Batu Ferringhi, Penang style!**
