Enjoy in the morning the vivid city of **Mérida**. In Mérida you can experience the fusion of indigenous culture and European influence from the colonial period and the time of the big landowners. The **city tour** takes you to the **governor's palace**, the oldest **cathedral of Mexico** and the former residence of the founder of the city, **Francisco Montejo**. **Chichén Itzá** one of the **seven new world wonders**, famous because of the political importance in the **Mayan times** as well as the impressive construction style, for instance of the **pyramid Kukulkán**. Refresh yourself with a **bath in a cenote**, one of the 2000 registered **limestone caves** on the **Yucatan** peninsula. For the Mayans those cenotes were said to be the access to the underworld.
