Day - 6 Phnom Penh

PHNOM PENH: ROYAL PALACE, NATIONAL MUSEUM, CENTRAL MARKET, WA PHNOM (B, L)

Your first stop today is the Royal Palace, built in 1866 and the Silver Pagoda located within the Royal Palace. The Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5,000 silver tiles. Continue to the National Museum, dedicated exclusively to Khmer art and sculpture. The majority of the exhibits are from the Angkor period (9th to 15th century), but some date from as early as the 4th century. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the Central Market (Psar Thmei), a large market constructed in 1937 in the shape of a dome with four arms branching out into vast hallways with countless stalls of goods. The four wings of this gigantic yellow dome are teeming with stalls that sell goods ranging from gold and silver, antique coins, money exchange, books, flowers, food, fabrics, shoes, souvenirs, seafood and countless other products. Last stop for today, the impressive Wat Phnom, an ancient pagoda on a hill, which marks the legendary founding place of the city.
