LANGKAWI: CABLE CAR & ORIENTAL VILLAGE

Enjoy the exhilarating 920m long cable car ride to the summit of the famous Mount Mat Cincang. Visitors can enjoy spectacular views of the Andaman Sea and the smaller islands of Langkawi. On clear days, one can also see the edge of Thailand in the North and Indonesia towards the South-West. Enjoy the cool air and the highland's view before proceeding down to the Oriental Village. It is one of the unique shopping, cultural and culinary destinations. Bold displays of culture, fashion, and handicraft with over 470 brands and 17,000 products. The village offers shopping buffs a wide range of international designer labels and local products.

LANGKAWI: NATURE CYCLING AND VILLAGE TOUR

Nature in Langkawi offers far beyond just the white sandy beaches and blue emerald waters of the Andaman Sea. This mystic island has been blessed with generous bounty and wide variations of nature. You can take a guided cycling tour to explore the countryside of Langkawi, visit the villages, local market and ride by the river banks, paddy fields, forests etc. This is a leisure ride to enjoy the nature and the rural areas of the island. At Atma Alam, you will get to witness the process of traditional batik printing using wax and dyes. Then, the statue of an Eagle which symbolizes Langkawi dominates this Eagle Square. Photos taken with this majestic bird is a must for a visitor to Langkawi. Get also a look at the local town of Kuah Town and enjoy some light duty-free shopping.
