JAISALMER: CITY- & DESERT TOUR (B, D)

Explore one of the largest forts of the world – the Jaisalmer Fort. The majestic fort's yellow sandstone walls are a tawny lion colour during the day and turn to a magical honey- gold during the sunset against the picturesque yellow desert. During your tour visit the Gadisagar Lake – a rainwater reservoir built in 1367; the delightful Folklore Museum and the famous Nathwon and Patwon ki Havelis. Later in the afternoon, drive to the outskirts to view the sunset on the picturesque sand dunes and enjoy a camel ride.
