

GOLDEN TRIANGLE – JEWELS OF INDIA

Day - 2 Delhi

Delhi (B, D)

Enjoy a guided tour of Old Delhi and New Delhi which includes driving past the Red Fort, a visit to Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in Asia, walk through the bustling lanes of Chandni Chowk and Raj Ghat, the simple but moving memorial to Mahatma Gandhi. Later, drive past the imposing India Gate, Rashtrapati Bhawan (the President's residence) and end the tour with a visit to Qutab Minar, a masterpiece of perfect proportions, and the tomb of Emperor Humayun.
