

GOLDEN TRIANGLE - JEWELS OF INDIA

India's 'Golden Triangle', the cities of Delhi, Agra and Jaipur, is the centerpiece and the repository of an extraordinary abundance of history, culture, and architecture of Northern India. This journey combines the country's capital city Delhi to the wondrous sites of the Mughal capital of Agra.

Day - 5 Jaipur

Jaipur (B, D)

Proceed for a tour of the fabulous hilltop citadel of Amber Fort, en route taking a photo-stop at Hawa Mahal, a five-storied wonder with a spectacular pyramidal facade. Located at the top of a hill, Amber Fort offers a spectacular view of the old town below, where Akbar stopped en route on his annual pilgrimage to Ajmer. Continue to Anokhi Museum of Hand Printing, to observe the consuming and exhausting method of hand-block printing in entirety, from carving of wooden blocks to the transformation of raw fabric into a piece of art. Afternoon enjoys the city tour including a visit to the City Palace Museum, which has a superb collection of Rajasthani costumes and armory of Mughals and Rajput and the aweinspiring Jantar Mantar Observatory. You may want to walk around the colorful bazaars and enjoy a traditional sweet at a renowned sweetshop.
