MELNIK – SOFIA DEPARTURE (B)

The first stop for the day is at the Sintika Winery, a fascinating combination between tradition and innovation. Besides autochthone sorts of grapes, many rare and exotic species and plants are grown onsite like Gingko Biloba, Kermes Oak, Cypress, citrus trees, and many more. The journey then takes you back to where it started: Sofia, the capital city of Bulgaria, where another UNESCO site will be visited. Located at the skirts of Vitosha mountain, the Boyana Church was built in three stages: in the late 10th and early 11th, the mid- 13th, and the mid-19th centuries. After your visit, it's time for your flight home or onward flight.
