Day - 3 Massai Mara

LAKE ELEMENTAIA – MAASAI MARA (B, L, D)

Today's drive takes you through dry lands and large wheat plantations. Stop first at Narok for a break. This town is run by the local Maasai people and don't be surprised to see cows walking around. The stretch from here to the Reserve is over a tarmac road and thereafter 70kms will be on a rough and bumpy track. Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch and take a brief nap. Experience an evening game drive in search of The Big Five.
