JOGJAKARTA ARRIVAL – BATIK COURSE – DINNER RAMAYANA DANCE (D)

Arrive at the Jogjakarta airport in the afternoon and meet with your guide. Before setting off for your afternoon excursion, enjoy some free time to refreshment. Have a chance to be introduced to one of Indonesia's most famous crafts with a visit to a traditional batik factory. Here, you are not only getting a brief story about the ancient techniques of Batik and observe skilled craftsmen, but you also have the chance to create your own batik. Start from scratch, making a design, applying wax and mixing your own dye. Your creation will be delivered to your hotel after drying. Tonight, you will be treated by a performance of traditional Ramayana Dances while dining at a local restaurant.
