

# Gobi Loop – Southern Mongolia

The coldest desert of the world in summer is surprisingly warm and full of life. Expect amazing wildlife, stunning nature and impressive nomadic life, blending 21st century technology with centuries old nomadic traditions. This trip covers everything the Gobi has to offer, from rocky canyons to steep cliffs, high mountains to flat plains and frozen rivers to flaming cliffs.

## Day - 10 Khugnu Khan

#### KARAKORUM - KHUGNU KHAN (B,L,D)

Along the road back to UB, we stop for one last night in Khugnu Khan. This sandy area is a natural replica of the ecosystem of the Gobi, almost 100km to the south of Khugnu Khan. We will ride camels into the dunes, hike through the sand and enjoy for one last time the tranquility of the Mongolian countryside.
