

## Family Cycling Hue And Hoi An

This cycling journey will take you to breathtaking destinations and backroads you could not explore any other way. It is a unique experience to get to know culture and nature of this breathtaking country.

### Day - 4 Hoi An

#### HUE – HOI AN (B, L)

Today we leave **Hue** for **Hoi An**, a major Asian trading port in the 17th and 18th centuries whose architecture and relaxed lifestyle has changed little over the years. The scenic route passes through the wonderfully photogenic fishing village of **Lang Co** before climbing over the Pass of Ocean Clouds. Driving through **Danang** we visit the **Cham Museum**, which contains the finest collection of Cham sculptures in the world. In the afternoon hop on a bicycle for a country loop around **Hoi An**. Starting from **Hoi An** city centre, we ride through an array of back roads in peaceful villages with lots of vegetable farms. You can stop at a pagoda, have a cup of tea and have conversations with the monks (subject to availability). You can also join the farmers in preparing the land and fertilizing it with seaweed if you like. Continue by overcrossing **Cam Thanh islet** and discover how locals turn coconut leaves into roofing for houses. Keep cycling along **Thu Bon river**, take a chance to paddle in a local basket boat known as a “**thung chai**”, before arriving at a fishing village where you can settle down beside a water coconut palm plantation and watch the sun setting over the horizon.
