

# Vietnam UNESCO World Heritage

The UNESCO World Heritage Sites highlights the rich cultural of Vietnam. The beautiful landscapes attract millions of local and foreign tourist. From the well known My Son Santuary to the great Phong Nha - Ke Bang National Park.

## Day - 3 Ninh Binh

#### HANOI - NINH BINH (B, L)

After breakfast drive through northern Vietnam to the site of Vietnam's first capital, Hoa Lu. Visit the temples that are dedicated to Emperor Dinh Tien Hoang of the Dinh Dynasty and Emperor Le Dai Hanh of the Le Dynasty. After visiting Hoa Lu, take an half-hour walk up of one the surrounding limestone karst hills, the climb is rewarding with spectacular views. Depart for Tam Coc Town for a Vietnamese lunch and on the way you can take pictures of local villages and the stunning landscape. After lunch, you visit Trang An Landscape Complex which was listed as an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take a relaxing boat ride on a peaceful river passing through a series of caves. Tran An is a spectacular landscape of limestone karst peaks permeated from valleys, some of which are submerged and surrounded by steep cliffs. As the boat gently slices through the water, notice the enormous limestone karsts jutting out from the green rice fields. In order to get more out of your adventure, climb up to Bich Dong Pagoda, established on the Ngu Nhac Mountain and dated back to 1428. After that, you drive back to Tam Coc town. Transfer to your hotel and the rest of the afternoon is at your leisure.
